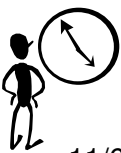

Free Batteries

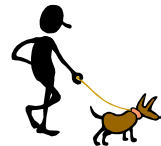


The Yarriambiack Shire Council in conjunction with the CFA and Duracell have a number of Free Batteries for SMOKE DETECTORS to give away.

ANIMAL REGISTRATIONS

All Cats and Dogs three months or older must be registered with Council.

All cats and dogs were required to be registered by the 10th May 2009.

Residents who failed to renew their animal's registration by this date will now incur an additional \$10 administration fee.

The Ranger / Local Laws Officer is currently door knocking residents who are yet to renew their animal registrations.

Food Safety Training Incentive for Businesses and Individuals

Council is seeking expressions of interest for food business proprietors and staff who would like to undertake food safety training. Individuals involved in sporting clubs or community groups are also encouraged to register their interest with the Shire.
