The purpose of this position is to assist both Horsham Rural City Council and Yarriambiack Shire Council in the preparation and implementation of a Regional Environment Strategy (RES).

The Suitable candidate will;

- Prepare an Environment Strategy for the municipalities of Horsham and Yarriambiack
- Facilitate and encourage community groups and individual contributions to the Regional Environmental Strategy
- Establish links with appropriate individuals, local conservation groups and other groups in the community
- Investigate and research environmental issues of the area and to advise on potential solutions.
- Document the Regional Environmental Strategy and assist the Wimmera Mallee Sustainability Alliance Steering Committee as required.
- Advocate processes to implement the Regional Environmental Strategy
- Liaise with State Government Departments and Statutory Authorities on environmental issues as required
