- **Outstanding Club Award** – recognising outstanding achievement by an amateur sporting club or team.
- **Community Participation Award** – recognises initiatives that encourage people to actively participate in physical activity. The initiative could be a one-off event or a longer-term program.
- **Sport and Recreation Education Award** – for outstanding achievement in sport and recreation education initiatives in both traditional and non-traditional educational settings.
- **Sport and Recreation Research Award** – for significant research of value to the sport and recreation industry.
- **Young Person in Sport Award** – for outstanding contribution by a young person (aged 14-21 years) to the industry as a whole or a specific sector.
- **Volunteer Involvement Award** – recognises the contribution made by a volunteer to the industry as a whole or to a specific industry sector.
- **Access for All Award** – recognises a group or individuals who have demonstrated strong commitment to encouraging and supporting people from a diverse community to participate in sport and recreation activities.
- **Community Facility Design Award** – recognises new or refurbished sport and recreation facilities with a focus on excellence in planning and design and a demonstrated impact on participation.
