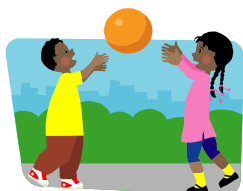

ANIMAL REGISTRATIONS

All Cats and Dogs three months or older must be registered with council. The Animal registration period ends April 10th each year. All cats and dogs must have their registration renewed by this date. Residents who fail to renew their animal's registration by 30th April will incur an additional \$10 administration fee.
