

## COMMUNITY GRANTS FUNDS APPLICATIONS DECEMBER 2005

Groups or organisations wishing to make application for grants should contact Pam Pittwood Executive Assistant at the Municipal Office 34 Lyle Street Warracknabeal 3393 tel: 5398 0104 to obtain application forms.

All recreation, service and community volunteer fund raising organisations which are formally constituted organisations, located within the boundaries of the Yarriambiack Shire Council municipal boundaries are eligible to apply for assistance under this scheme.

Grants are not available for administration costs, repair of equipment, rates, power costs, telephone and other re-current costs of community groups. Grants will not be backdated. One allocation per group annually – if your group received an allocation in the previous round your application will not be considered.

Applicants for Community Grants are required to provide details of their group or organisation, their activities, other funding sources and the purpose for which the funds will be used if granted.

**Applications close at 4.00pm on Friday 4 November 2005.**

All applications will be considered but not necessarily funded by the Council. The maximum grant available for each group is \$500.
