Mobile Transfer Station Service

Overview

As of July 2026, eligible Yarriambiack residential properties are able to book a hard waste collection via the **Mobile Transfer Station Service**.





The service is available to:

- **Seniors Card** Holders,
- **Disability Health Care Card** Holders,
- All residents of **Yaapeet** and **Patchewollock**.

The **Mobile Transfer Station Service** collections will occur on Thursdays, focusing on different areas of the Shire on a rotational timetable:

1st Thursday of the Month	SOUTHERN COLLECTION AREA
	Murtoa, Minyip, Rupanyup, and Lubeck.
2nd Thursday of the Month	CENTRAL COLLECTION AREA
	Warracknabeal, Brim, and Beulah.
3rd Thursday of the Month	NORTHERN COLLECTION AREA
	Hopetoun, Woomelang, Speed, Tempy, and Lascelles.
4th Thursday of the Month	SPECIAL COLLECTION AREA
	Yaapeet and Patchewollock.

To arrange a collection, an eligible resident will need to:

-  Make a collection **Booking**,
-  Receive collection **Acknowledgement**,
-  Resolve the collection **Payment**,
-  Prepare the **Collection**.

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Bookings

The **Mobile Transfer Station Service** works on a pre-booked system.

There are a maximum of 6 collections available for each collection Thursday.

Bookings must be requested at least 2 weeks prior to the collection Thursday for the associated collection area.

Collections will be allocated to the next available collection Thursday for the associated collection area.

The following information is required to make a collection booking request:

- **Eligibility Information** - Seniors Card, Disability Health Care Card, or resident of Yaapeet or Patchewollock.
- **Contact Information** - name, phone number, email.
- **Collection Location** - address and description of collection location.
- **Collection Items** - list of large and small items, with an estimated size/weight.

Acknowledgement

Collection booking requests will be acknowledged to the resident within 2 business days from when the request is received by Council.

A proposed collection date will be provided during the acknowledgement.

The contact details provided as part of the booking request will be used to acknowledge and confirm the collection details. A booking will not be acknowledged unless contact can be made with the resident.



No waste or recycling items are to be presented without confirmation from Council. Any items presented without acknowledgement and confirmation of collection will be considered as illegal waste dumping.



Payment

A collection will not be taken until payment is made - payment can be made via:

On The Collection Day:

With a card payment (subject to availability of telecommunication connectivity) or with a correct cash payment (change not available).

Service fee charged at **\$45 per cubic metre** (maximum of 3 cubic metres per collection). Some items will be charged separately as per Transfer Station fees (mattresses, tyres, etc).

A reminder will be sent to the resident a day prior to the collection to confirm the payment and collection arrangement.

Collection

Items must be neatly stacked on the nature strip and must fit within 3 cubic metres (example collection layout: 3 metres wide x 1 metres high x 1 metres deep).

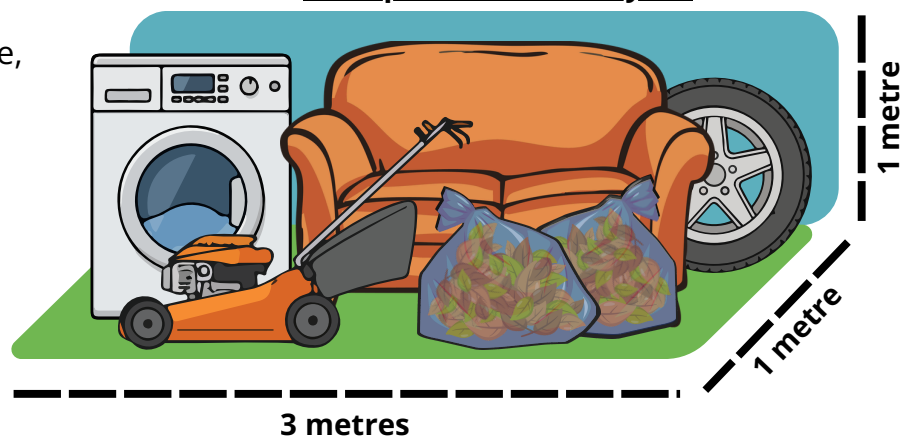
Individual items should not exceed 1.5 metres in length/width/height and must be able to be safely lifted by no more than 2 people - **at the discretion of staff**.

Items exceeding the maximum volumes will not be collected.

If more than 3 cubic metres of hard waste is presented for collection, items will be collected according to the following priority groups (up to the permitted volume):

- **Priority 1:** furniture; timber.
- **Priority 2:** white goods (fridge, oven, washing machine, dish washer); small car parts; lawn mower; tools; hot water systems; metal waste.
- **Priority 3:** televisions; electrical appliances; e-waste.
- **Priority 4:** all other items.

Example Collection Layout



Only items that are listed in the booking request will be collected.

Items for collection must be put out within the week of the confirmed collection day.

Item List

Individual items must not exceed 1.5 metres of length/width/height and must be able to be safely lifted by no more than 2 people - **at the discretion of staff.**

Small or loose items must be secured and contained within a bag/box or bundled.
