

How do I know which insurance to get?

If you have contents insurance most insurers provide legal liability cover automatically. However, Council asks that you speak with your insurer for confirmation.





What is Personal Legal Liability Cover and Public Liability Insurance?

Personal Legal Liability Cover

If the contents in the home you live in are insured, you are covered for your legal liability which occurs within Australia. This covers you from any damage done to other people and third-party property while undertaking personal firewood collection. It does not cover personal damage to yourself, your own property or family members property. This cover is automatically in effect once your content insurance commences.

Public Liability Insurance

Is designed to provide protection for you, in the event that injury to a person (not yourself) or third party, or damages to property occur during the course of your operations.



What is a Certificate of Currency?

A Certificate of Currency (also known as a Certificate of Insurance) provides proof that you are covered by an insurance policy, and it lists the details of that policy.



Why do I need Insurance to Collect Wood from the Roadside?

To ensure you are covered if there are any injuries obtained by a third party or damages to property.



What is Damage to Property?

'Damage to property' means physical injury to or destruction of tangible property, and resulting loss of its use. Tangible property includes the cost of recreating or replacing stocks, bonds, deeds, mortgages, bank deposits and similar instruments but does not include the value represented by such instruments.

How do I get Public Liability Insurance?

From an Insurance Company or Insurance Broker.
