

- 01. Upgraded north-west entry (signage and safety rails)
- 02. Upgraded entry (fencing, vehicle and pedestrian gates)
- 03. Remove the existing play node and Charles Ayrey Pavilion. Re-develop a new play facility outside the fencing of the new bank of courts
- 04. New electronic scoreboard (operated from the community pavilion)
- 05. Aluminium bench seats around the oval
- 06. Covered deck to provide an entry and an additional gathering space to the western side of the community pavilion
- 07. Demolish the former kitchen/social room. Replace with an open gathering area with barbecue
- Updated central amenities building 08.
- 09. Indoor sports facility upgrade (synthetic grass and retractable netting)
- Indoor sports facility nothern entry hard surface upgrade

- Indoor sports facility external wall enhancement (art and/or murals) 11.
- 12. New storage facility
- 13. Remove the former CFA training facilities
- 14. Additional wind break trees
- Updated eastern amenities building 15.
- 16. Oval upgrade (re-shaping, irrigation, drainage, goal catch nets and recycled plastic picket fencing)
- 17. Grandstand upgrade (transparent wall panels)
- 18. New 2-net cricket practice facility
- 19. Covered hard surface spectator zone
- 20. Remove the southern bank of tennis courts
- 21. Suitable barrier (such as mass planting or fence screens)
- Restrict unnecessary vehicle access on the western side of the oval.
