

1. EVALUATION CRITERIA

Applications were evaluated in accordance with the qualitative criteria and weightings relevant to each funding stream. Funding streams are as follows:

- Community Share Grant - Event and Sponsorship (up to \$1,500 with no matching funding)
- Community Share Grant – Business and Streetscape (Up to \$2,000 with 1:1 funding)
- Community Share Grant – Community Building Minor Grants (up to \$3,000 with no matching funding)
- Community Share Grant – Community Building Major Grants (up to \$10,000 with 3:1 matching funding)

2. EVALUATION SCORES

Evaluations were conducted independently through an online link to the submissions and scorecard. Scores from the three evaluations were totaled and the final score is identified in the attached evaluation spread sheet. A maximum score of 90 was possible, while a minimum score of 45 was required to be funded.

3. SUMMARY

There were 27 submissions requesting a total of \$92,487.91 for round 2 of the Share Grant program. Applications were of a high quality with 18 applications scoring above the minimum score and 3 applicants deemed ineligible as per the guidelines of the stream.

The available budget of \$37,408.40 allows for the highest scoring 10 applications to be fully funded, with the eleventh scoring application partially funded.

The funded applications related to the following streams.

- 3 x Community Events
- 2 x Business & Streetscapes
- 1 x Community Buildings - Minor
- 2 x Community Buildings - Major (Fully Funded)
- 1 x Major Community Buildings – Major (Partially Funded)
