FEES AND REQUIREMENTS

- Permit application fee is \$65-00.
- All Permit fees must be paid when the application is lodged with Council.
- The application fee is non-refundable, and any permits issue are subject to a property/location inspection prior to the permit’s approval.
- No activity stated on an application is to commence prior to the permits issue.
- Permits issued shall include various set standards to be maintained by the applicant.
- Any breach of these conditions may result in the permit being cancelled until the breach is rectified.
- If a breach of this permit is not rectified within the specified time Council may order the permanent removal of the offending items, and penalties may apply.

LIFE OF PERMIT

- For Dogs and Cats, the permit shall remain in effect for 2 years from the date of issue.
- For all other animals the permit shall remain in effect for 1 year from the date of issue.
- For all remaining activities the permit shall remain in effect for 1 year unless otherwise specified by the issuing Officer.

PRIVACY / PROCESS

As part of the application process, your application may be considered by Council at a meeting that is open to the public, and that the information provided in this permit application form may be disclosed for that purpose.
